

INSOL Reimagined

INSOL International is calling on its global network to aid in the forging of a strategic pathway for the future of INSOL International.

A new phase of strategic planning is beginning at INSOL International, with a focus on setting ambitions for 2025 and through to 2030. Wide consultation and eliciting stakeholder perspectives on the future of INSOL are central drivers as the future of INSOL is reimagined.

The ambitious Toward2021 Strategic Plan, launched in 2017 is now coming to an end, having made great strides towards achieving our Vision and Purpose of being a truly global, member driven, organisation influencing global insolvency and restructuring practice and policy. It is therefore timely to consider all that we have achieved and to direct our collective aspirations toward new horizons.

There are many examples of what has been achieved on this journey so far. The INSOL Asia Hub was established in Singapore in August 2019, led by an Advisory Council to further promote INSOL across Asia. The foundation of three new colloquia: the Regulatory and Legislative Colloquium, the Financiers Colloquium and the Mediation and Arbitration Colloquium to complement the well-established colloquia – the Judicial Colloquium and the Academic Colloquium. In response to global forces, plans for new methods of communication have been accelerated, leveraging technology globally which has swiftly evolved into part of INSOL's business-as-usual offering, including the design and implementation of a Virtual Conference across multiple time-zones.

Members, INSOL's Member Associations, G36 and the creativity of a dedicated TaskForce were the collective cornerstones supporting the building of the Toward2021 Strategic Plan. It is clear that the future of INSOL should be driven by the very stakeholders whom INSOL wishes to benefit through its endeavours. This collaborative approach is key to ensuring the global needs of the industry are not only met, but anticipated ahead of time to enable all members to be equipped to meet the challenges of the future from a position of enlightened expectancy.

The consultation and research phase for the reimagining of INSOL is now underway, more details of how to contribute and form part of defining the strategic plan will be released over coming weeks.
